**JUNIOR CHURCH IS BACK UNTIL JUNE 5<sup>TH</sup>!** Families have the option of attending in person or participate at home. Children that want to join us in person will begin in the sanctuary seated with the grown up they came with and then head as a group to the auditorium during the Children’s hymn. If lifestyle makes it easier to follow along at home as a family, sign up with Rev. Rachel in time to receive your at home package.

**HOSPITAL VISITATION:** Due to ongoing Covid Restrictions at PEI Hospital facilities clergy are only allowed to visit the hospital if called in by hospital staff, a family member on behalf of a patient, or the patient themselves. Clergy can only visit that one patient at this time following the hospital protocols. Once regular weekly clergy visitation is reinstated we will let the congregation at Trinity know. Rev. **KOREA PEACE APPEAL:** The United Church of Canada is responding to an urgent invitation of the National Council of Churches in Korea to join in the Korea Peace Appeal. The goal is to collect signatures—very simple!

In July 2023, it will be 70 years since the armistice was signed; technically, the war is not over. Both North and South Korea have used the conflict as an excuse to perpetuate violations of human rights to maintain power. Countless resources have been focused on military spending and millions of Korean families remain separated from each other on opposite sides of the border, sealed in 1953.

What can we do? Visit The United Church of Canada website at [united-church.ca](#), and the very first item to pop up is the Korea Peace Appeal. Click on “Sign the Petition,” a page will pop up with background information, prayers, stories, etc. Another box, “Sign the Petition,” is at the top of that page—click. At the bottom of the page, highlighted in blue and white are the words, KOREA PEACE APPEAL Sign Here—click. A very simple page will pop up asking your name, country, email, affiliation (add The United Church of Canada, if you wish), and then hit “send.” If you choose to share your email, you will receive an electronic certificate that confirms you are part of the appeal for peace.

On April 22, Rev. Rachel linked the Trinity facebook page directly to The United Church of Canada under a link called “Act Now.” The Korean Peace Appeal can also be accessed from there.

If you don’t have access to a computer and would like to sign the appeal, lists will be at the church entrances on Sunday mornings or call the church office and leave your name and telephone number.

10:30 a.m. In Person and Livestream Worship Available (Doors open at 10 a.m.)

No capacity limits. No Registration is Required.

Entire sanctuary will be open for seating where you so choose, but we ask you to respect the comfort of all congregants around physical distancing.

Masks will no longer be mandatory but if you want to sing, please wear a mask for the safety of yourself and others (this is consistent with other UCC congregations until covid rates decline further).

Offering plates will continue to be available at the entrances but we highly recommend congregants contact the Church Office about other ways to give like: E-Transfer, Pre-Authorized Remittance, etc. Thank you for your continuing support of the Ministry at Trinity.
