He has served in various positions - minister of pastoral care and worship, managing pastoral care in hospitals, established a Clinical Pastor Education program, served as an intentional interim minister on many occasions, as well as transitional ministry, hospital chaplain, and supply minister. He currently is a Chaplain with the RCMP and is a casual employee with Health PEI as a Spiritual Care Clinician.
